We live at [REDACTED] Mile End SA 5031, Australia. We are concerned about the proposed zoning application in our area and the drastic changes it could lead to in the community. Our main concerns are the potential for heritage houses to be replaced with high density housing or commercial enterprise. This is a family neighbourhood, which holds fantastic heritage and amenity value, similar to the surrounding parts of Mile End that have not been zoned as 'housing diversity neighbourhood zone'. For consistency across the greater Mile End/Torrensville area, and maintaining the current look, feel and function of our direct neighbourhood, we object to re zoning to a 'housing diversity neighbourhood zone'. Instead we think a Suburban Neighbourhood Zone is most appropriate.
