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To whom it may concern

I would like to provide feedback on the draft Planning and Design Code for SA.

I reside at 21 Darebin Street, Mile End and strongly object to the proposed changes, which will have a detrimental effect on my neighbourhood.

Character homes in this area should be looked after rather than continually demolished, or subdivided into small boxes which are not in keeping with the character of the area.

I do not want the part of Mile End that I reside in to be a "Housing Diversity Neighbourhood Zone", but rather I believe it is more appropriate classified as a "Suburban Neighbourhood Zone".

For far too long Mile End, and neighbouring suburbs such as Torrensville and Thebarton have been divided depending on which side of South Rd you might happen to live on, including the recent impact of the farcical school zoning decision.

Keep these character areas together by zoning ALL parts of Mile End as a "Suburban Neighbourhood Zone".
